
Tigers at My Door Forte and Piano with Scale Steps







Teacher Note: A colorful paper wad, etc. may locate the opening C key. Two items may mark the G key.

Tips from the Tigers:

- 1. Circle f or p for the animal sounds on the next page.
- 2. Use a 2-1 donut and play the TIGER KEYS on the piano with the Teacher Duet or CD. Your teacher will guide you. Notice that "key 5" is played TWO times!
- 3. Listen for f and p sounds.

1, 2, 3, 4, 5 puppies at my door!




5, 6, 7, 8
