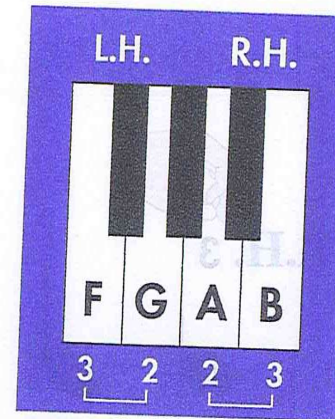


Riding the Escalator

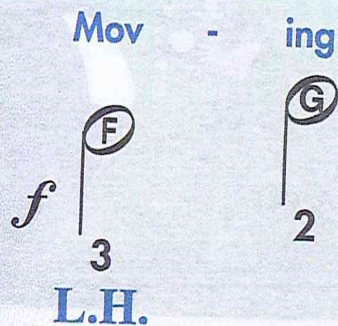
Tips from your friends:

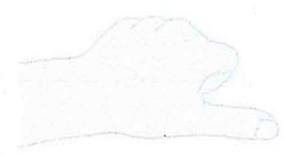
