



Dallas Dips R.H. Donuts Sounds Going Higher on White Keys








HIGH

When you play the high keys, the sounds are higher!



1. In the air with your teacher:

Pretend to dip a R.H. 3-1 donut in milk by dipping from your wrist. Say, "Dip, dip, dip, dip."

2. On the keyboard:

Start on MIDDLE C using a R.H. 3-1 donut. Play all the white keys going HIGHER—to the right. Then play, keeping a steady beat with the teacher duet or audio!

Teacher Duet: (Student begins on Middle C.)
