
## The V<sup>7</sup> Chord

V is the Roman numeral for the number 5.

The  $V^7$  chord (pronounced "five-seven") is a 4-note chord.


In this book, a simplified (F 2-note version of the V<sup>7</sup> chord is used.





the dominant, step V

Play the chords below and say their names aloud.










Franz Joseph Haydn (1732-1809, Austria) arranged
